INDIVIDUAL POINTS SYSTEM – Each race will assign points based on the winning men’s/women’s results according to the “Ranking points breakdown: 100-88-78-72-68-66-64-62-60-58-56-54-52-50 down to 2 points and down to the 40th position for men and women”. The overall top points results will be used to determine the series winner, however if the participant does all 4 races, the best 3 results will be used. If tied in points, the last race will determine the overall result. If still tied in points based on last race, then the 2nd last race will determine the final result if tied.
